

Verónica Perera has a Licenciatura in Sociology from Universidad del Salvador in Buenos Aires (1993) and a MA in Economic Sociology from Instituto de Altos Estudios, Universidad Nacional de San Martín (1999). In 1999 she moved to New York City where she lived until2013. In 2007 Verónica received her Ph.D. in Sociology from the New School for Social Research.
